From the Directors:

While the initial thought was that our 2020 theme meant Going Beyond by expanding our ministry by purchasing land to build a 2nd campus up in the mountain community of Cañas, God had a different plan. Instead we “went beyond” by extending our ministry to include Covid and hurricane relief. Both of these new ministries were not normal ministries for MIEA, but the staff stepped up in incredible ways and financial resources came in that allowed MIEA to step up to the tasks as they presented themselves. The hurricane relief was also “beyond” as it is almost 3 1/2 hours to the north, which made logistics tricky. Through these 2 new ministries, we were able to Go Beyond with the Hope of Jesus Christ in ways that would not have been available to us otherwise.

We are continuing our theme of Going Beyond into 2021 with plans to continue going forward to purchase land up the mountain to begin developing our satellite campus. We are excited by all that God continues to do through El Ayudante, and we appreciate all the partnerships we have to move God’s plans forward.

2020 MIEA Activity Report

2020 was a very different year for Mision Internacional El Ayudante. Due to the Covid crisis, ministry looked a little different but many amazing things still took place. Below is a brief summary of activity.

122 water filters were installed

1747 water filters were checked

27 Latrines were installed

5 cement floors were poured

Built an adobe home using ALL of the EA staff

9 couples were married

13 days of VBS were provided

5 Family Nights took place

8264 medical patients were seen

2704 dental patients were seen

128 ultrasounds were performed

92 names were passed on from Spiritual Care to local pastors

4649 tests in our new medical lab

3 pastor's trainings were provided

112 high school scholarships were provided up from 92 the year before

5 university scholarships were provided

4752+ hours of tutoring were provided (3rd -12th grades) despite Covid and distance learning

Started a chick coop project

Sponsored 15 high school students in the mountain

Started tutoring in the mountain

Installed a new playground on campus

Performed a study on malnourished children

Distributed 2375 bags of food totaling 42,750 pounds during the Covid crisis

Distributed seeds for families to start gardens

Distributed fertilizer to local farmers to help ensure a good crop

Completed a new staff house

Built an addition to the clinic for xray and ultrasound

Started an addition onto the LC for a library and extra storage

109 team members and 8 interns/volunteers came to volunteer at EA

Completed outfitting and painting the school addition in the mountain

Began hurricane relief in the area of La Lima on the North coast

Began an “adopt-a-family” program to restore people’s homes (cleaned out all the mud and restocked them with the items necessary to start life over(refrigerator, table and chairs, beds, linens, dishes and other kitchen items etc))

Partnered with Ministerio Linaje Escogido Comayagua to provide a Christmas program for a tent city in the hurricane area providing food and gifts for more than 300 people along with the message of Christ and hope for the future.

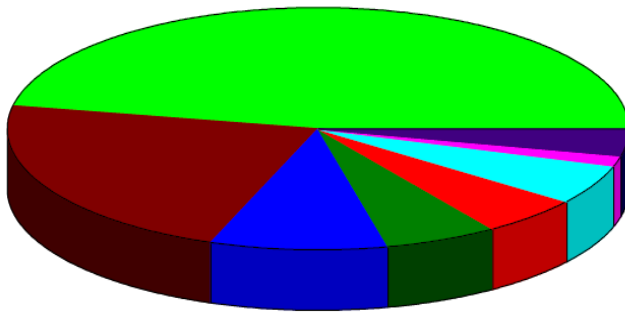




2020 Financial Information

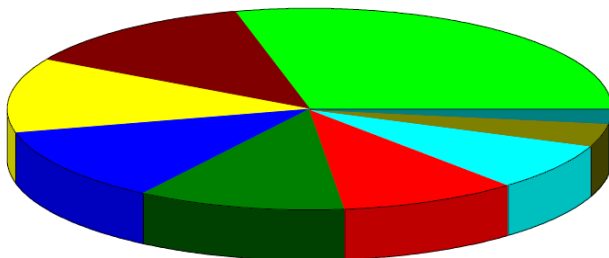
Income Summary
