# 2021 MIEA Activity Report

It was wonderful to be doing projects in our communities again in 2021. Some relational ministry was still on hold due to Covid, but many construction projects took place. In addition to community projects close to home, we worked in the hurricane ravaged area of the North Coast for the first 6 months of the year. Below is a brief summary of activity.

148 water filters were installed

1246 water filters were checked

23 Latrines were installed

15 cement floors were poured

3 adobe homes were built

14 chicken coops were built in our communities

8092 medical patients were treated

3579 dental patients were treated

547 patients (medical and dental) were treated in our satellite mountain clinic

181 ultrasounds were performed

138 names were passed on from Spiritual Care to local pastors

4115 tests in our new medical lab

12 days of pastor's trainings were provided

148 high school scholarships were provided up from 112 the year before

8 university scholarships were provided

11,758 hours of tutoring (grades 5-12)

4919 hours were spent in the computer lab

Built a library and storage room onto the Learning Center

Revamped and revitalized the soccer field

Provided 6 months of hurricane relief in the north coastal area to include:

85 houses were cleaned to removed the mud (sometimes knee deep)

600 food bags were distributed

75 families received kits to replace their ruined household items (beds, fridges, tables etc)

118 roofs got replaced

183 team members and 8 interns/volunteers came to serve at EA

Built a classroom in the mountain community of La Brea

Began construction on a church in the mountain community of Corralitos

Gave 10 computers to a local school

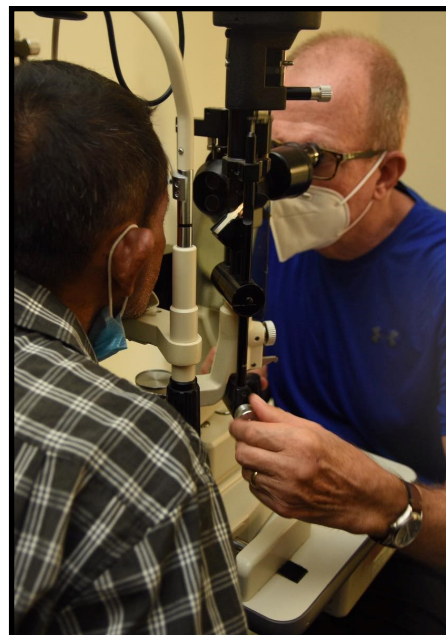
Held workshops for women on sewing, jewelry making and hair cutting

Hosted a 6 week fitness club for middle school aged girls

Distributed 23 bags of fertilizer to local farmers

Offered extracurricular book clubs, English classes and computer workshops

Invested \$250,000+ into the community in salaries and contract labor





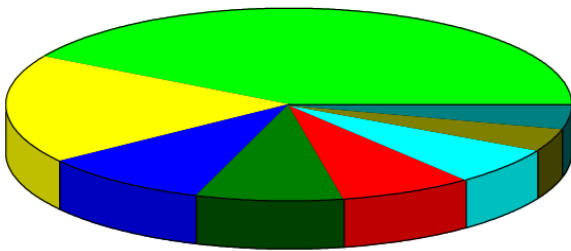


# 2021 Financial Information

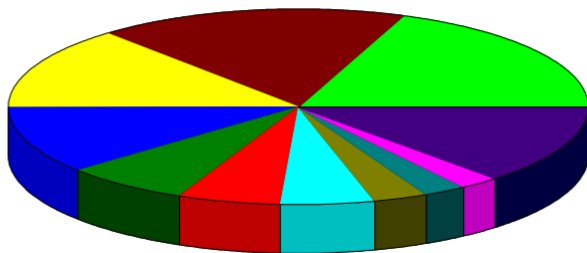
