## **2022 MIEA Activity Report**

It was wonderful to be doing projects in our communities again in 2022. Teams were back and relational ministry was back to 100%. We focused on really expanding our presence and touch in our mountain communities, but continued to invest in our valley communities as well. Below is a brief summary of activity.

145 water filters were installed

1204 water filters were checked

62 Latrines were installed

21 cement floors were poured

2 adobe homes were built

9 chicken coops were built in our communities

58 pilas were constructed

40 days of VBS took place

20 Family Nights took place

9630 medical patients were treated

4078 dental patients were treated

444 patients seen by a specialist (in house)

982 patients (medical and dental) were treated in our satellite mountain clinic

242 ultrasounds were performed

146 names were passed on from Spiritual Care to local pastors

4311 tests in our medical lab

7 days of pastor's trainings were provided

124 high school scholarships were provided

33 high school scholarships were provided in our mountain community

13 university scholarships were provided

11,758 hours of tutoring (grades 5-12)

4919 hours were spent in the computer lab

12 couples completed our marriage course and were married at EA

10 Women's conferences were hosted

13 roofs in the community were provided

264 team members and 37 interns/volunteers came to serve at EA

Began building a Kinder in the mountain community of Cañas

Helped add a second level onto the church in Playitas

Gave computers to a local schools

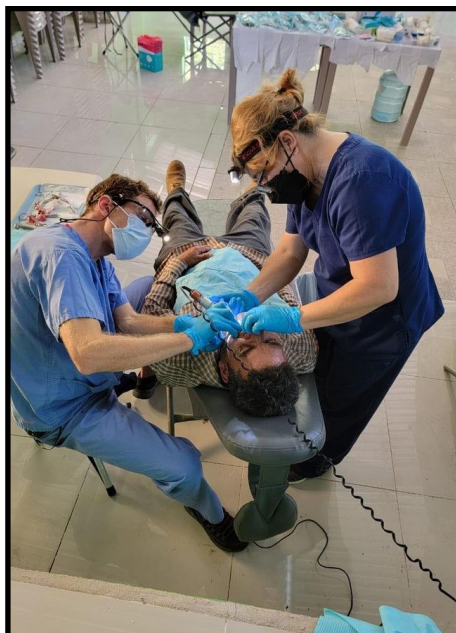
Offered a welding course to students

Offered extracurricular book clubs, English classes and computer workshops

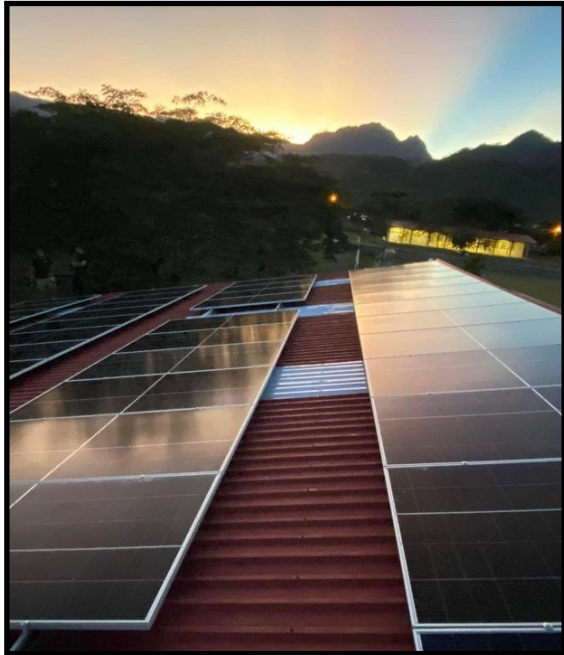
Purchased 3 new trucks to replace some older vehicles

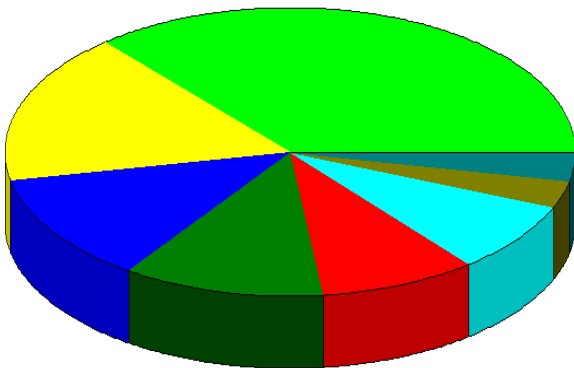


# 2022 Financial Information

January through December 2022

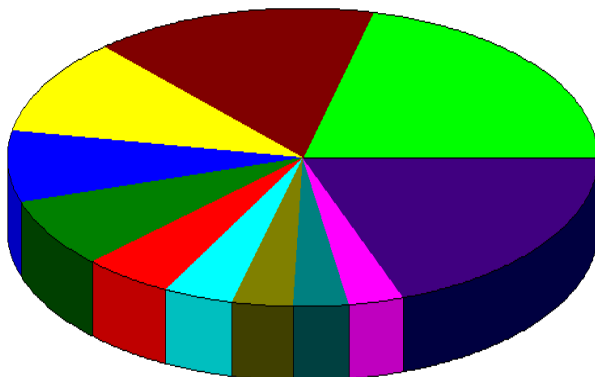
