2023 MIEA Activity Report

2023 was a robust year for teams coming down to serve, and many amazing things took place. Below is a brief summary of activity.

195 water filters were installed

1257 water filters were checked

56 Latrines were installed

12 cement floors were poured

2.5 adobe homes were built

53 pilas were built

9576 medical patients were seen

3783 dental patients were seen

195 ultrasounds were performed

122 names were passed on from Spiritual Care to local pastors

4341 tests in our medical lab

18 women's conferences were provided

9 couples completed our marriage course

11 couples were married at ceremonies provided by teams at EA

48 days of VBS were provided

3 Swing Sets were installed

21 school projects were completed

1 new classroom was built in the mountain community of La Escalera

165 high school scholarships were provided up from 148 the year before

14 university scholarships were provided

11,098 hours of tutoring were provided (5th-12th grades)

1512 hours were spent in the computer lab

Provided a Spiritual retreat day for our scholarship students


Provided a Teacher Conference for local teachers





























2023 Financial Information


